Social Support Worker

The Migrants Commission is seeking to recruit a part-time (casual basis) Social Support Worker to provide residential services on a shift basis.

The selected candidate will form part of a dedicated team providing accommodation and support to residents and their children as they navigate trauma recovery and integration. The Social Support Worker will play a key role in fostering dignity and self-esteem, contributing to care plans and collaborating with other team members to ensure comprehensive, person-centred support.

The ideal candidate must:

- Have a minimum of two (2) years of experience in a similar role.
- Have a recognised qualification in Residential Care Work or in working with vulnerable persons at MQF Level 3 or higher. Other qualifications in the social field will be considered an asset.
- Have good interpersonal and communication skills written and verbal, particularly in English.
- Possess the ability to manage stressful situations.
- Have a flexible approach to the needs of the service.
- Possess a clean driving license.

Students working towards such a qualification are also encouraged to apply.
